



New Study Finds Mismatch Between Observing and Reporting Suspected Research Misconduct

A study of suspected research misconduct by the Gallup organization in collaboration with the Office of Research Integrity suggests there is a large discrepancy between the number of incidents of suspected research misconduct observed by researchers and the number of such incidents reported to ORI. The study findings are presented in the June 19, 2008 issue of the journal *Nature*.
